PARALLEL NARRATIVES: PERSONAL STORIES, SHARED RESONANCES

Parallel Narratives brings together four artists whose distinct visual languages are united by a shared engagement with personal experience. Through abstraction, reinterpretation, and symbolism, the exhibition considers how memory, emotion, and everyday life are translated into visual form, revealing the ways personal narratives resonate beyond the self.

American artist **Braxton Fuller** approaches art as a space for introspection and emotional dialogue. Beginning as a poetry writer, he developed minimalist, text-based works that merge conceptual ideas with abstraction, capturing fleeting emotional states through sharp observations and a subtle sense of humour.

Indonesian artist **Rai Julian** approaches painting as an extension of lived experience. Born in Bandung and now based in Bali, his work is shaped by the people and communities around him, weaving together personal memories and shared moments through vibrant, uplifting compositions.

Colombian artist **Javier Caraballo** draws inspiration from the stages of children's artistic development, incorporating spontaneous "naive stains" as the foundation of his visual language. By layering these gestures with references to modern and contemporary art - from Picasso and Miró to KAWS and Murakami - he reinterprets familiar imagery through a lens of innocence, playfulness and instinct. His work highlights the enduring power of childlike expression within contemporary practice.

Chinese artist **Song Wei** explores the tension between tradition and contemporary life through works that juxtapose cultural symbolism with everyday imagery. Drawing on his experience of growing up in China during a period of rapid change, his practice brings together the visual language of blue-and-white ceramic traditions with forms drawn from popular culture, reflecting both cultural contradiction and personal negotiation.

Together, Braxton Fuller, Rai Julian, Javier Caraballo, and Song Wei present four parallel yet distinct modes of storytelling. Brought into dialogue, their works reveal how personal narratives can unfold through different forms while remaining connected by shared human feeling.
